Dear Roxana Senior High School Parents,

Your child has recently taken the STAR Reading and STAR Math computer-adaptive tests. The enclosed reports summarize your child's scores. As with any test, many factors can affect a student's scores. Each report is slightly different in the information that it contains. It is important to understand that these reports provide only one picture of how your child is performing in each specific subject as compared to other students in the same grade.

These assessments are given to all students a minimum of 3 times per year. Results are then used to modify instruction to meet the specific needs of each student. The performance categories for *STAR Reading and STAR Math* are as follows:

Category	Percentile Ranking
Excellent	75th Percentile and Above
Proficient	50th - 74th Percentile
Slightly Below Proficiency	25th - 49th Percentile
Below Proficiency	10th - 24th Percentile
Well Below Proficiency	Below the 10th Percentile

Please review your child's reports and discuss the results with them. You do **not** need to sign or return the reports.
