All students Pre-K through 12th grade will have the option for either In-Person Learning five days a week on the current abbreviated day schedules or Remote Learning five days a week. We are excited to increase the in-person option to five days a week for high school students. Even with the potential for increased class sizes, we will continue implementing all mitigation strategies including socially distancing students to the greatest extent practical. We are thankful that the number of cases has declined and that vaccination availability continues to increase in our region.

The learning model chosen is a commitment for the entire fourth quarter. Please review the remote learning expectations document closely before indicating your choice.
